#### Pig census shows a stabilistion of the breeding herd in England

The Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs' (DEFRA) recently published pig census for England in December showed that pig numbers totalled 3.3 million pigs – putting the total population at 3.3 million pigs. This is a decline of 10 per cent compared to one year ago.

The breeding herd remained steady, however. Compared to one year ago, the number of breeding sows rose by 0.7 per cent to 239,000. The number of pregnant sows rose by 3.5 per cent to 175,500 head.

The number of gilts and young sows fell by 16 and 7 per cent respectively.


The figures for the pig population for the UK as a whole will become available when the censuses are published for Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.



### Pig slaughtering in the EU fell by 7.3 per cent in 2023


All EU countries have now reported figures to Eurostat for the development in pig slaughtering for the whole of 2023.

The two diagrams below show the development in EU slaughtering and the eight largest pig producing countries in the EU in 2023 and the quarterly development in EU slaughtering for the period 2021-2023.

### USDA: expects a modest rise in EU pig slaughtering in 2024

Based on December's EU pig census, the USDA has upgraded its expectations for EU pig slaughtering in 2024.

USDA now expects EU pig slaughtering in 2024 to rise by 1.5 per cent to 225 million pigs. The outlook from the USDA was previously for a modest fall in EU slaughtering to 220.0 million. For beef the USDA expects EU production to be largely unchanged in 2024.

#### First shipment of Russian pig meat to China

International news media report that Russia despatched 27 tonnes of pig meat to China last week. This is the first time for Russian pig meat to be exported to China since 2008.

Russian pig meat has been banned for export to China since 2008 because of African Swine Fever. In September, however, the Chinese authorities lifted the import ban and since then, three Russian companies have been approved for pig meat exports to China.

According to the Russian National Union of Pig Breeders, Russia hopes to secure 5 per cent of China's pig meat imports.

According to figures from Russia's Agriculture Ministry, Russia exported around 255,000 tonnes of pig meat in 2023. The two largest export markets were Vietnam and Belarus.

**USDA** extends trial period allowing a higher slaughter rate at pig slaughterhouses According to Pig 333, the USDA has announced that the period allowing a number of U.S. pig slaughterhouses to operate at a higher slaughter rate is to be extended once again.

Permission for a higher slaughtering rate will now apply until 15 January 2025. A report will then be drawn up which will provide the basis for possible future legislation on the maximum rate.

The trial began back in March 2022. It allows certain slaughterhouses to operate at rates that exceed the current maximum slaughter rate of 1,106 pigs per hour.

Under the Trump administration, the maximum slaughter rate was lifted. However, a court decision in March 2021 decided that, to safeguard the safety of slaughterhouse workers, a maximum limit should apply.

The United Food and Commercial Workers (UFCW) Union are supporters of a maximum permitted slaughter rate at slaughterhouses.

However, the North American Meat Institute, which represents U.S. slaughterhouses, previously warned that lower slaughter rates could lower slaughter capacity by 80,000 pigs per week and mean higher costs for slaughterhouses.
