SWITZERLAND

Preparations for possible outbreak of African Swine Fever

With African Swine Fever in northern Italy just 60 km away from the Swiss border, Switzerland is drawing up contingency plans for a possible outbreak of African Swine Fever, reports several news outlets.

The Swiss veterinary authorities have announced three measures which will come into force if wild boar carrying the African Swine Fever virus are found in Switzerland.

First, control zones will be established to prevent the virus from spreading. Arrangements will also be made to instigate a rapid search and disposal of dead wild boars. Thirdly, intensive hunting will be used to reduce the wild boar population if this proves necessary.

Individual cantons will also be able to limit public access to forests that are at risk of infection.

Protective fencing at the Swiss-Italian border is not planned due to the topography.



Floods hit slaughterhouses in Rio Grande do Sul

The southern Brazilian state of Rio Grande do Sul is currently affected by severe flooding.

The state produces both cattle and pigs on a large scale (the third largest state in terms of pig population).

As flooding has impacted the infrastructure, the slaughter of poultry and pigs in the state has also been affected, reports international news media.

Reuters, citing local sources, reports the flooded roads have hit 12 poultry slaughterhouses and five pig slaughterhouses.



Calls for 'free from foot and mouth disease - without vaccination' status

Last week, the authorities in Brazil declared the country free from foot and mouth – without vaccination.

Approaches will now be made to the World Health Organisation in the hope that the country can achieve international status as free from foot and mouth disease – without vaccination – with effect from May 2025.

The new self-proclaimed status comes after Brazil completed a vaccination programme against foot and mouth disease in a number of northern states at the end of April.



EU Commission expects EU pig meat production to be unchanged in 2024

Last week, the EU Commission published its latest short-term outlook for EU agricultural markets, with its preliminary estimate for 2023 and outlook for 2024.

The table below shows the EU Commission's outlook for changes in the EU's production, export and consumption of pig meat in 2023 and 2024 compared to previous years.

As can be seen, the Commission expects a sharp fall of 6.6 per cent in the EU's pig meat production in 2023 and largely unchanged production in 2024.

As regards beef, the EU Commission expects a 2.3 per cent fall in production in 2024. This follows a 3.6 per cent fall in production in 2023.

As regards poultry, the EU Commission expects a rise in EU production of 1.7 per cent in 2024 following a rise of 2.4 per cent in 2023.

AUSTRALIA

Increasing imports from North America

The table below shows Australian imports of fresh/frozen pig meat by country for Q1 2024 compared to the same quarter in 2023 and 2022.

As can be seen, following a sharp fall in 2023, Australian imports in Q1 2024 increased and returned to the level from 2022.

Increasing imports from the US and Canada have contributed to the overall rise in imports. By contrast, imports from EU countries - Denmark, Holland and Ireland - fell in 2024.

NEW ZEALAND

Largely unchanged pig meat imports in Q1 2024

New Zealand's pig meat imports in Q1 2024 are slightly down on the same quarter last year.

The table below shows New Zealand's fresh/frozen pig meat imports by country for January-March 2024 compared to the same period in the previous two years.

As can be seen from the figures, there was a rise in imports from Canada and the U.S. Imports from Denmark also increased while there was a decline in imports from a number of other EU countries.

Rise in U.S. pig meat exports

With U.S. export statistics as the source, the table below shows U.S. exports of fresh/frozen pig meat and by-products by country for Jan-March 2024 compared to the same period in 2023 and 2022.

As can be seen, exports of fresh/frozen pig meat in Q1 2024 were 7.9 per cent higher compared to the same quarter last year while exports of by-products rose by 4.6 per cent. In 2023, export figures for Q1 were higher than the previous year.

As regards fresh/frozen pig meat, the rise in exports to Mexico - the largest export market for American pig meat – continues. South Korea, Columbia and Australia have seen significant increases in U.S. exports of fresh/frozen pig meat.

As regards by-products, there was a slight decline in exports to China in Q1. This, however, was more than offset by volume increases in exports to Mexico and a number of other markets.

Rise in Canada's pig meat exports

With Canada's export statistics as the source, the tables below show Canadian exports of fresh/frozen pig meat and by-products by country for Jan-March 2024 compared to the same period in 2023 and 2022.

As can be seen, Canadian pig meat exports increased in Q1 this year compared to the corresponding quarter last year.

As regards fresh/frozen pig meat, exports are 13.7 per cent higher than last year. Following a decline in 2023, exports in Q1 have now returned to the level from 2022. There were significant rises in fresh/frozen pig meat to Japan, Philippines, South Korea and Australia in Q1 this year.

As regards by-products, there was a sharp rise in Canadian exports to the largest market, China, in Q1.
