Seven wild boar found dead from African Swine Fever in Fagersta on Sunday

In Fagersta, 145 km north-west of Stockholm, the authorities have embarked on a search for dead wild boar in the area. This follows the discovery that a dead wild boar in the area was infected with African Swine Fever.

On Sunday, at least seven wild boar were found in the area as a result of African Swine Fever. More can be expected in the coming days.

The search, which is assisted by hunters and tracking dogs, is mapping out the extent of the area affected by the disease. The authorities have blocked off an area of 800 sq.km. in the first instance.

A number of restrictions have been introduced to prevent unnecessary public access, e.g. the picking of berries and mushrooms, hunting, tree felling and other outdoor activities in the area are prohibited.



Borders closed to pig meat from Sweden

A number of countries have closed their borders to pig meat from Sweden after African Swine Fever was found in wild boar in the country.

According to the Swedish media, countries that have taken action include Japan, South Korea, Philippines, Australia and Ukraine. The Swedish authorities report that around half Swedish pig meat exports have now been affected.



Pig slaughtering fell by 2 per cent in H1 2023

Statistics from Sweden's Board of Agriculture show that Swedish pig slaughtering fell by 2 per cent in H1 2023 compared to the same period last year.

EU

EU pig slaughtering fell by 8.9 per cent in H1 2023


Pig slaughtering in the EU was 8.9 per cent lower for the period Jan-June 2023 compared to the same period last year. This is shown by the EU countries' preliminarily reported figures to Eurostat.

Thus, the trend towards a decline in EU slaughtering has intensified since Q1 when slaughtering was 7.7 per cent lower than last year.

In H1 2022, slaughtering was 3.4 per cent lower than last year while H2 saw a fall of 6.6 per cent. For 2022 as a whole, pig slaughtering fell by 5.0 per cent compared to 2021.

Greece is the only EU country that, at + 3.8 per cent, recorded an increase in pig slaughtering in H1. Otherwise, the decline ranges from -2.0 per cent in Sweden to -19.1 per cent in Denmark.

The development in EU slaughtering for the eight largest pig producing countries in the EU is shown in the following chart.



🚟 ENGLAND

Lowest pig population in 12 years

Last week, the British authorities published the preliminary results of the pig census for England for 1 June 2023.

The figures show the total pig population in England totalled 3.633 million head on 1 June. This is an 11.6 per cent decline year-on-year and the lowest pig population since 2011. The fall has been driven by a corresponding fall of 12-13 per cent for both piglets and finishers.

However, the development in the breeding population is more stable. Compared to one year ago, the number of sows fell by 1.5 per cent while the population of pregnant sows declined by 3.0 per cent. The number of gilts in pig and the number of gilts intended for breeding increased by 8.9 per cent and 8.3 per cent respectively.

The figures for the UK pig population as a whole will be available when a corresponding census has been published for Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.



May-June pig census

Eurostat has so far published the results of its May/June pig census for countries, Germany, France, Denmark (1 July), Holland and Austria. The results, along with those for Serbia, are shown in the table below.

13 EU countries are expected to publish their figures for the development in the pig population for May/June 2023 compared to May/June 2022. Figures for the other 8 EU countries together with the UK are expected to be published by Eurostat over the coming weeks.

Buy-out scheme for pig farms extended

Only 236 out of 980 pig farms in Flanders have so far chosen to accept an offer of support to cease pig production.

As a result of the lower-than-expected take-up, the authorities in Flanders will expand the scheme so that up to 3,000 pig farms can apply for support to cease production, writes Pig333. This means that around 80 per cent of pig producers in Flanders are now covered.

The scheme, which is expected to run until 30 June 2025, was introduced to reduce nitrogen emissions. EUR 200 million has been earmarked for the buy-out of small and medium-sized pig farms in Flanders.



VAT exemption period extended

Last week, the Portuguese government decided to extend the period for removing 6 per cent VAT on a number of food products, including meat.

The decision to lower VAT took effect on 18 April and 6 was scheduled to apply at the end of October. The period has now been extended by two months to apply to the rest of the year.

The removal of VAT was introduced in an attempt to combat the inflation that has hit consumers.




