BELGIUM

Authorities in Wallonia step up the battle against wild boar

Pig333 reports that the authorities in Wallonia in Southern Belgium are to intensify the hunt for wild boar.

Feeding stations will be introduced and the hunting season will be extended. In future, it will be permitted, under special conditions, to hunt wild boar from open planes. And in areas where hunting is difficult, traps will be allowed.

Wallonia was hit by African Swine Fever in 2018. However, the disease was successfully eradicated in the demarcated area, and since then, the authorities have allowed extensive hunting of wild boar.

Although 92,000 wild boar have been shot in Wallonia since 2019, the authorities do not think that this is sufficient, which is why the hunt is being intensified.

AUSTRALIA

Hunt begins for growing wild boar population and feral pigs

In New South Wales, the authorities have embarked on an intensive hunt for wild boar and feral pigs.

The feral pig population has increased enormously in recent years and is believed to have reached 24 million.



Pig meat storage 14 per cent lower than one year ago

With the USDA as the source, the table below shows the latest calculations for U.S. storage of pig meat as at 30 September compared to last year and to one year ago.

As at the end of September, total pig meat storage was 14 per cent lower than one year ago. Compared to the previous month, storage is down by 1.4 per cent.

Beef storage as at 30 September is 6 per cent higher than the previous month, but 20 per cent lower than one year ago. As regards poultry, storage fell by 1 per cent and is on a par with one year ago.

As was published in last week's Market News, figures from the Chinese authorities put the sow population at 42.4 million as at the end of September.

This is unchanged from last month and a fall of 2.8 per cent compared to one year ago.

Rising productivity, however, is expected to more than offset the fall in the sow population.
