Fall in futures prices last week

As can be seen on page 1, American hog futures prices fell last week.

According to Reuters, the reason was largely owing to widespread concern about the prospect of an imminent trade conflict with China, Canada and Mexico.

A fall in the US consumer confidence index was also a contributory factor.

Pig census 1 January

At the end of February, the authorities in Canada published the results of the pig census carried out on 1 January 2025.

Compared to one year ago, there was a slight decline in both the breeding herd and in the piglet and finisher populations.

Canadian slaughtering numbers fell by 1.0 per cent to 10.7 million in H2 2004.

Exports of live pigs from Canada for H2 2024 landed at 3.3 million head – a fall of 3.6 per cent compared to the same period last year, reports Statistics Canada.



USDA forecasts increased U.S. pig meat production in 2025

Last week, the USDA published their latest Outlook Report with their forecast for the production of various meat types in 2025.

USDA expects that U.S. pig meat production in 2025 will be 2.7 per cent higher than in 2024. This follows a 1.8 per cent rise in 2024.

The table below shows the USDA's forecast for quarterly pig slaughtering next year. The second table sets out the expected annual production for various meat types.

As can be seen from the above table, total pig meat storage as at the end of January was 4 per cent higher than the previous month and 12 per cent lower than one year ago. Storage of bellies increased on the previous month but is 32 per cent down on the year.



Senate approves Jamieson Greer as new Trade Representative

The United States Senate has voted, 56-43, to confirm Jamieson Geer as the new United States Trade Representative.

Greer is a prominent trade lawyer who, according to U.S. media, has been a strong critic of China's trade practice. The appointment signals an aggressive trade policy towards China.

The US Trade Representative is an important position in the U.S. administration and is responsible for developing and providing proposals to the President on the U.S.'s trade policy.



The U.S. Secretary of Agriculture addresses American agriculture's labour concerns

During her speech at the USDA's annual Agriculture Outlook Forum, Brooke Rollins emphasised that ensuring sufficient labour for U.S. agriculture is of top priority.

According to Rollins, the subject is raised in every conversation she has with the industry.

Her remarks come at a time when the American agricultural sector is battling with uncertainty about future labour as a result of President Trump's immigration policy, which calls for mass deportation of immigrants and stricter border controls.

Rollins assured her audience that she understands agriculture's concerns and that she and the President will try to meet the industry's labour requirements. However, she pointed out that she is fully behind Trump's immigration policy.



November 2024 pig census shows stable German pig population

Last week, the German authorities published the final figures for Germany's pig population as at November 2024 compared to the previous year.

Compared to the preliminary figures published in December, there have been no major changes. The census continues to show stable development of the German pig population.

The breeding herd in November 2024's census is unchanged compared to one year ago, while the total pig herd is 0.3 per cent higher compared to one year ago.

The number of pig farms continues to fall, but at a slightly lower rate than has been evident from previous censuses. Finisher farms saw a 2.9 per cent fall in one year, from 13,600 to 13,200, while sow farms fell by 3.8 per cent from 5,200 to the current 5,000.

The number of boars in the 2024 census has not been provided because the random sample was too small.



Production and imports of pork to remain steady in 2025

In its latest pork market outlook, AHDB forecasts that pork production and imports in 2025 will remain steady in 2025.

British pork production for 2025 is expected to remain unchanged at 960,000 tonnes. Average carcase weight is also expected to remain unchanged at 90 kg.

British pork production increased by 3.7 per cent in 2024. Slaughtering numbers for finishers increased by 2.8 per cent to 10.33 million head and a higher carcase weight contributed to a 3.7 per cent rise in total pig meat production.

As regards pig meat imports in 2025, AHDB expects a marginal rise of 1 per cent.

In 2024, total British imports of pig meat also rose by 1 per cent to 783,000 tonnes.

Imports of fresh/frozen pig meat increased in 2024 by 2.4 per cent to 339,400 tonnes. Denmark, Germany, Spain and Belgium are the largest exporters to the UK market. However, bacon imports fell by 2.2 per cent to 176,500 tonnes. In this respect, almost all imports came from the Netherlands and Denmark, with the Netherlands as the largest supplier at more than 100,000 tonnes.

Other British imports included processed pig meat, sausages, etc and were from a number of different exporting countries.
