After a six-month reprieve Poland reports one outbreak of African Swine Fever at a pig farm

For the first time since last September, Poland has reported an outbreak of African Swine Fever at a pig farm. The incident was confirmed at a small farm of 16 pigs not far from the border with the Czech Republic.

As can be seen from the above table, Poland has experienced almost 1,200 cases of African Swine Fever among wild boar so far this year but none at pig farms until now.

📒 DENMARK

Structural development

Last week, Statistics Denmark published the results of the annual agricultural census (summer) for 2022.

With the census as the source, the tables below show the structural development in the number of farms and pig farms for the period 2022-1990.

Again with the census as the source, the pig population is shown by region for the period 2022-2018.

As this is a random count, the individual year's figures are subject to some uncertainty.





Sow population 0.9 per cent lower than one month ago

According to Reuters, which cites China's Agriculture Ministry, China's sow population stood at 43.05 million at the end of March. This is a fall of 0.9 per cent compared to the previous month.

The total pig population stands at 430.94 million, which is a rise of 2 per cent compared to one year ago.



Pig slaughtering in Q1 was 1.7 per cent higher compared to the same quarter last year

Figures from China's National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) show that 198.99 million pigs were slaughtered in Q1, up by 1.7 per cent.

A higher carcass weight meant that measured in terms of meat, pig production in Q1 increased by 1.9 per cent, which corresponds to 290,000 tonnes more pig meat.

🛄 USA

U.S. court approves settlement whereby Smithfield pays USD 75 million

Last week, an American court approved a settlement agreed last year whereby Smithfield undertakes to pay USD 75 million to a group of consumer organisations who accused Smithfield and a number of other companies of restricting supply to keep prices artificially high.

In his judgement, the District Judge in Minneapolis described the resolution as fair, reasonable and adequate.

Smithfield Foods previously stated that the settlement does not mean that they are guilty of the charge but wish to remove the uncertainties and costs of lengthy legal proceedings.

As mentioned, the case was brought by a group of consumer organisations. In addition to Smithfield, companies such as JBS, Tyson and Hormel have also been accused of price fixing. JBS previously entered into a similar settlement and paid USD 20 million.

IM CANADA

Olymel closes slaughterhouse in Quebec with 994 redundancies to follow

Last week, the Canadian Olymel announced the closure of its slaughterhouse in Vallee-Jonction in Quebec.

According to CEO Yanick Gervais, the company plans to cut slaughter capacity by 1.5 million pigs, which is the main reason for the closure.

The shortage of labour and the need to upgrade the plant were also contributory factors.

The plant in Vallee-Jonction is one of four pig slaughterhouses in Quebec owned by Olymel.

SOUTH KOREA

Fall in imports from EU

The table below provides the official figures for South Korea's imports of fresh/frozen pig meat for January-March 2023 compared to the same period in 2022 and 2021.

As can be seen, South Korea's total imports of fresh/frozen pig meat for Q1 2023 are below those for the same period last year but higher compared to two years ago. Following a rise in pig meat imports from the EU in 2022, imports declined in Q1 2023. However, South Korea's imports from North America have so far increased in 2023.

South Korea resumed imports from Belgium in 2022 7 Fever in 2022.
