African Swine Fever in Lombardy

As was reported in last week's Market News, African Swine Fever has been confirmed at a pig farm in the Northern Italian province of Lombardy, Italy's largest pig producing region.

Last week, two more pig farms in Lombardy were hit by African Swine Fever.

In addition to the usual control regulations, the authorities have introduced stricter requirements for transporting pigs throughout the region.

The regional authorities have also approached the state authorities in Rome to request additional resources to control wild boar in Lombardy.

At meetings with Italy's Agriculture and Defence Ministers, the regional authorities have expressed their wish to intensify the hunting of wild boar in the region. With the backup of the army and the deployment of incentive schemes, this would strengthen the culling of wild boar in the region.



May-June pig census

Eurostat has published the results of the May/June pig census for Germany, Austria and Serbia. The figures, together with those for Denmark (1 July census), appear in the table below.

A total of 13 EU countries are expected to publish their figures for the development in their pig populations in May/June 2023 compared to May/June 2022. Figures for the other 10 EU countries, together with the UK, are expected to be published by Eurostat in the coming weeks.

EU and Australia resume talks on free trade deal

The Pig Site reports that the EU and Australia have resumed free trade talks. Negotiations began in 2018.

Negotiations broke down in July over access for Australian agricultural products, particularly beef.

Australia wants better access to the EU for its beef, lamb, dairy products and wine. Australia is also a major supplier of lithium and other minerals used in batteries and other electronic products.



Pig meat storage at low level in July

The latest figures from AMI for German storage of frozen pig meat in July show that storage amounted to 74,000 tonnes.

The fall in Germany's pig meat storage therefore continues. Storage amounted to 100,000 tonnes in April and 189,000 tonnes one year ago.

Since May 2022, when storage amounted to 212,000 tonnes, there has been an ongoing sharp decline.

AMI's figures are based on the German cold store trade association figures.



Pig census May 2023

The German authorities have published their final figures for the German pig population (May 2023 census).

Compared to the preliminary figures published last June, there has been a slight uplift for most categories of pig.

Whereas the preliminary figures showed an overall decline in the total population of 7.3 per cent, the final figures now show a decline of 6.2 per cent. As regards pregnant sows, the figures have been adjusted from a decline of 6.7 per cent to a fall of 5.6 per cent.

Slight fall in sow population

Reuters, citing China's Agriculture Ministry, reports that China's sow population in July was 0.6 per cent lower than both the previous month and one year ago.



Pig production expected to rise by 1.5 per cent this year

The Brazilian Animal Protein Association (ABPA) expects Brazil's pig meat production in 2023 to rise by 1.5 per cent to 5.1 million tonnes.

ABPA also expects sales of pig meat in the domestic market to total 3.85 million tonnes, while exports are expected to rise by 12 per cent to 1.25 million tonnes.
