#### Pig population 1 April 2024

Last week, Statistics Denmark published the results of the pig census carried out on 1 April 2024. The results are shown in the table below.

Compared to one year ago, the 1 April census shows a 6.8 per cent rise in the total pig population. This covers all pig categories except breeding boars.

The rise in the pig population – especially the 'finishers >50 kg' – should, however, be viewed against the background of a very low population last year.

Added to which is that fact that the number of finishers in the 1 April census is disproportionately high due to the many 'surplus' finishers that were not slaughtered during the Easter break.

Compared to the census from 1 January, therefore, the pig population is seeing a stable development where the total population has risen by a more modest 0.7 per cent.

The breeding population in the form of pregnant sows is 2 per cent higher than one year ago and is largely unchanged compared to the 1 January census.

The fact that the breeding population has stabilised and shows signs of being slightly higher than one year ago is due to the high piglet prices and the significant uplift in the economy of piglet production since the turn of the year 2022/23.

## **GERMANY**

#### Stable German pig slaughtering in Q1

Following a 7 per cent fall in slaughtering in 2023, the German authorities have reported that German pig slaughtering was stable in Q1 2024.

Slaughtering in Q1 totalled 11.1 million head, a rise of 3 per cent compared with the same quarter last year. A slightly higher carcase weight meant that – measured in tonnes – slaughtering increased by 1.1 per cent in Q1 compared to last year.

The latest calculations from AMI for German storage of frozen pig meat shows that storage totalled 102,000 tonnes in March.

This is a slight fall from 107,000 tonnes in February and slightly higher than the figure for one year ago – 93,000 tonnes.

Within an historical perspective, pig meat storage remains at a low level. In 2022, storage amounted to 182,000 tonnes at the same time of year.
