African Swine Fever spreads to new province in Liguria

As can be seen from the table above, the Italian authorities continue to identify new cases of African Swine Fever among wild boar.

The majority of cases have been found in the north-west regions of Liguria and Piedmont. As regards Liguria, cases were found in a new province - La Specia - at the end of March.



The results of the American pig census of 1 March

2024 were published last week by the USDA.

Compared to the corresponding census one year ago, the results show a slight rise in the total pig population whereas the breeding herd fell by 2 per cent.

Expected farrowings for the current quarter are 0.9 per cent lower than the same quarter last year while expected farrowings for the coming quarter are 1.7 per cent lower than last year.

The results of the 1 December census indicate that US pig production in 2024 will be slightly up on last year.

It seems that the poor performance of US pig production in 2023 has only resulted in a very limited decline in the breeding population – a fall that is more than offset by an increase in productivity.



Pig meat storage 12 per cent lower than one year ago

With the USDA as the source, the following table shows the latest calculations for US pig meat storage as at 29 February 2024 compared to the previous month and to one year ago.

Total pig meat storage was 12 per cent lower than one year ago and fell 1 per cent compared to the previous month.

Beef storage as at 29 February was 6 per cent lower than the previous month and 12 per cent lower than one year ago.

As regards poultry, storage fell by 1 per cent on the previous month and was 5 per cent lower than one year ago.

Four American welfare groups have filed a lawsuit in the US Federal Court to challenge the use of ractopamine in US meat production.

The animal welfare groups claim that the use of ractopamine harms animals both physically and mentally. In addition, they claim that its use can have a detrimental effect on human health, the safety of workers and the environment. The parties are calling for a reassessment of the use of the feed additive.



USDA: expects 2.5 per cent fall in slaughtering in 2024

The USDA has published its half-year report on Canada's pig meat market.

USDA expects to see a decline in Canadian pig production and slaughtering in 2024. From 2022 to 2023, slaughtering increased from 21.8 to 21.9 million head. For 2024, USDA expects a decline in slaughtering of 2.5 per cent to 21.4 million head.

The decline in slaughtering has the greatest impact in eastern Canada where slaughter capacity has recently been reduced.

Canadian pig meat exports in 2024 are expected to remain stable, ie. around 1.3 million tonnes.



AMI: German finisher producers in profit since spring 2023

Model calculations from AMI in Germany for German pig production show that pig producers have been in profit since the spring of 2023.

This follows an extended period – from 2020-2023 – of losses.

The model calculation for March shows a profit of EUR 11.70 per produced finisher. There is therefore a modest rise in profits compared to the previous months.

Although the cost of piglets is up compared to a few months ago, lower feed costs and higher finisher prices have compensated for this.



Sow population declines further and at end February was 6.9 per cent down on one year ago. The sow population in China continues to fall. However, the population is higher than the authorities' target of 39.0 million head.

According to Reuters, which cites figures from China's Ministry of Agriculture, China's sow population stood at 40.42 million head at the end of February. This is a fall of 6.9 per cent compared to one year ago and a fall of 0.6 per cent compared to the previous month.

As at the end of January, the sow population stood at 40.67 million and had declined 1.8 per cent on the previous month.



Imports of pig meat
