Rise in futures prices for pigs and pig meat

As can be seen on page 1, US futures prices for pigs and pig meat have shown a solid rise in the past week.

This is despite the fact that the latest US pig census showed that the pig population was larger than the market had expected.

The rise in futures prices is due to three factors: first and foremost, US pig meat exports are developing better than expected. Second, domestic demand is positive, and finally, pig meat storage is declining and is down on one year ago.



Rise in German pig slaughtering in the first two months of the year

According to AMI, German pig slaughtering at 7.5 million head was 5 per cent higher in the first two months of 2024 compared to the same period last year. A modest rise in carcass weight means that, measured in tonnage, production rose by 6 per cent.

The rise in German slaughtering follows in the wake of constant declines since 2016. German slaughtering fell by 9 per cent and 7 per cent in 2023 and 2022 respectively. In previous years, the decline has been between 2-3 per cent.



Authorities declare Chile free from PRRS

The authorities in Chile have declared the country free from PRRS. A national monitoring system has shown that the disease is no longer present in the country.

The declaration follows the Agriculture Ministry's PRRS control and eradication programme for the period 2014-2023.



Austria given green light for exports of by-products to China

International news media report that the Chinese authorities have granted access to the Chinese market for pig meat by-products from Austria.

Austria has had access to China since 2015 but this is the first time for by-products to be included.
