With regard to previous calculations, the European Commission has made adjustments to the 2024 figures for a number of countries. For Bulgaria, the number of cases among wild boar has been sharply reduced while there have only been minor adjustments to the figures for other countries.



Rise in imports of piglets from Denmark

AMI in Germany has reported a rise in imports of piglets from Denmark in the first four months of the year.

According to preliminary figures from AMI, imports of live pigs from Denmark to Germany in the first four months of the year have increased from 2,033 million head in 2023 to 2,455 million in 2024. By far the majority of the imports of live pigs from Denmark are piglets.

Imports of live pigs into Holland are reported to be unchanged. In the first four months of the year, imports totalled 1,333 million pigs compared to 1,304 million pigs in the same period last year.



Top ten German slaughterhouses in 2023

With ISN as the source, the following table shows the top ten largest pig slaughterhouses in Germany in 2023.

Although the list of the ten largest slaughterhouses is unchanged from last year, the continued decline in German slaughtering has resulted in a significant decline in slaughtering for a number of slaughterhouses.

In comments to the table, ISN points out that in 2023, a number of slaughterhouses made significant reductions to their slaughtering numbers. This applies to Tönnies in Sögel and Weisenfels, Danish Crown in Essen and Vion in Emstek

In addition, several regional slaughterhouses closed in 2023. This applies to Kronacher Schlachthof, die Schweineschlachtung München and Odenwald Schlachthof.

The closure of Vion's slaughterhouse in Emstek in 2024 may mean more pigs for Danish Crown and Tönnies, which have plants not far from Emstek.



Increasing meat exports

According to the director from the National Meat Association, Sergey Yushin, Russia's meat exports is expected to increase by a further 10 per cent in 2024, reports Pig333.

According to Yushin, Russia's meat exports also rose in 2023 and reached almost 1 million tonnes, i.e. \$ 2 billion in 2023.
