President Trump postpones tariffs for Canada og Mexico

As reported in the media, President Trump decided at the last moment to postpone tariffs on goods from Canada and Mexico for one month. However, 10 per cent tariffs are being maintained on goods from China.

Mexico, Canada and China had previously warned of retaliatory tariffs on a number of American products.

Mexico's retaliatory tariffs were to cover a number of American agricultural products, including pig meat. Mexico is the most important market for U.S. pig meat. In the main, Canada's retaliatory tariffs did not include pig meat, although specific processed meat products were listed. Pig meat is not included on China's retaliatory list.

The U.S. pig meat industry has expressed relief that the trade conflict with Canada and Mexico has been temporarily put on hold and are pressing for a long-term solution to avoid a trade conflict that will hit their industry.



Pig population 1 January 2025

Statistics Denmark has just published the results of the pig census conducted on 1 January 2025. The results are given in the following table.

Compared to one year ago, i.e. the 1 January 2024 census, there is an increase in the total pig population of 1.9 per cent while, compared to the 1 October census, the total population is almost unchanged at -0.2 per cent.

Only in the Finishers > 50 kg is there a slight fall of 1.9 per cent compared to one year ago. However, the finisher population is on a par with 1 October census.

The breeding population in the form of pregnant sows increased by 2.1 per cent compared to one year ago and by 1.4 per cent compared to the 1 October census.

Exports of U.S. pig meat rose by 5 per cent in 2024

With U.S. export statistics as the source, the following tables show U.S. exports of fresh/frozen pig meat and by-products by country for 2024 compared to 2023 and 2022.

As can be seen, exports of fresh/frozen pig meat in 2024 were 4.7 per cent higher than in 2023 while exports of by-products saw a marginal fall of 0.9 per cent. In 2023, U.S. exports of pig meat increased compared to the previous year.

As regards fresh/frozen pig meat, the increase in exports to the main export market, Mexico, continues. There was also a significant increase in exports of fresh/frozen pig meat to South Korea, Columbia and Australia as well as to a number of countries in Central America.

However, there was a significant decline in exports to China and a slight decline in exports to Japan. There was also a decline in exports to Canada in 2024 following a strong increase in 2023.

As regards by-products, there was a decline in exports to China. However, this was largely offset by volume increases to Mexico, Philippines and a number of other markets.

🛅 AUSTRALIA

Strongly increasing imports of pig meat from U.S.

The table below shows Australian imports of fresh/frozen pig meat by country for 2024 compared to the two previous years.

As can be seen from the figures, Australian imports increased on the year but are down compared to 2022.

In the past two years, there have been sharp increases in Australian imports of pig meat from the U.S. Imports from Canada also increased while imports from EU countries such as Holland and Ireland fell over the same period.

In 2024, imports from Denmark increased compared to 2023 but are significantly under 2022's figures.

Increasing exports of piglets to Spain

Dutch exports of piglets to Spain have seen increases for a number of years. According to Pig 333, Dutch exports of piglets stood at 192,000 head in 2016. Since then exports have increased year by year, and in 2024, exports reached 2,362 million.
